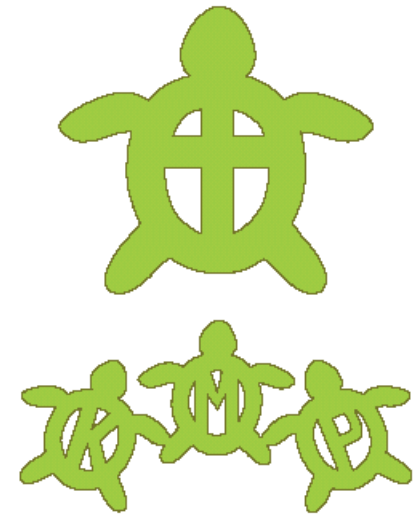

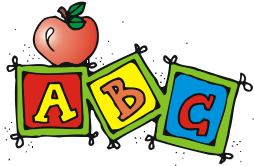

KAILUA METHODIST PRESCHOOL

We begin our day by gathering as a school ohana and saying the Pledge of Allegiance then singing two songs before separating into age level groups for morning circle.

The Three year olds are just beginning to relate to others in a school situation, the goals of these classes are to develop socialization, listening skills, attention to task, simple safety rules, encourage good health, and develop an awareness of God. The teacher helps the children to achieve these goals through literature, storytelling, music, learning centers, art projects, cooperative play and sharing. Another important goal is for the family and the teacher to become partners who communicate freely and openly for the benefit of the children.



The focus of the young four year olds and PreKindergarten classes are listening and socialization skills. Christian values and morals are emphasized. In addition to the storytelling, music, learning centers, and art projects: the children work on a variety of activities to build self-confidence and self-control. They have a journal that they write in weekly. They may be practicing letter writing or recording their experiences and feelings in art form which the teacher labels for them. Other skills introduced in these classes are: identification of, sounds (phonics) and writing practice of upper and lower case letters; identification, and comprehension of numerals 1 through 20; and recognition of colors and shapes.

KMP has excursions and special in-house events monthly, and offers, for an additional charge, extra-curricular activities which may include Prime Time, Hula, Sweet Art, and Worship Ballet.

FEES:

Application Fee:

An initial, nonrefundable fee of \$25.00 turned in with your child's application form to KMP

Registration Fee:

An Initial nonrefundable fee of \$100 is due upon acceptance into KMP.

Tuition Deposit Fee:

An initial, non-refundable fee of \$100.00 is due upon acceptance into KMP and is applied to your first month tuition.

Comprehensive Supply Fee:

An annual, nonrefundable fee of \$150.00 is due every August. If your child is enrolled in the summer program a nonrefundable \$50 fee is due in June.

Change of Clothes:

A complete change of clothes in a zip top plastic bag



Lunch:

Provide a healthy lunch each day for your child. We have refrigerators to keep them in and microwaves to warm up pre-cooked foods.

Nap Time:

Blanket and/or pillow to sleep with that will easily fit into your child's cubby.

KMP provides care for children:

From the age of three (3) through five (5) Children are admitted on a space-available basis regardless of race, color, sex, national or ethnic origin.

All children attending the preschool must be fully toilet trained.
